Articles should be 250-500 words long, providing information of interest to your peers. Please include color photographs whenever possible and a color head shot of you, so that we can post your photo with your article. We are looking for the following types of member articles:

2. Spotlight on service: Let us know about student volunteer activities in your school or area.
3. College application process: Let us know about your experiences with the college application process, taking the SAT's, or anything along those lines that you would like to share with other students.
4. Travel news: If you have any student travel experiences you would like to write about, please submit (exchange programs, Presidential Classroom and other Washington D.C. trips, international programs, etc.)
5. Please do not submit fiction or poetry for the newsletter.
