This scholarship is for the program cost of one Semester at Sea fall 2010 program to be awarded to an NSHSS member demonstrating outstanding achievement and financial need. Applicants must have completed at least one semester of college coursework. The scholarship covers the entire program cost, which offers up to 12 credit hours through the University of Virginia. The student is responsible for air fare costs. Also you should apply for additional financial aid through the Semester at Sea program as well. Be sure to review guidelines and deadlines on the Semester at Sea website, and you will also need to apply for the program itself on the Semester at Sea website. **Semester at Sea will waive the \$50 program application fee for all members.
