










With world events today, to what degree do you feel anxious or depressed?






Do you expect to live at home for one year or more after college?





To what degree do you think misinformation is a problem with our news today?








How often do you fact check news you see on social media?




How often do you fact check news you see on social media?




Do you have a clear plan for what you want to do for a career?




Do you understand how to manage your personal finances?





Key Takeaways

- Al is a job threat. More than one third (38%) worry that Al might replace them in their jobs in the next 10 years.
- Misinformation is rife. Every single respondent 99% said misinformation is a problem with our news today.
- **No trust in social news.** The same holds true for social media: **93**% factcheck news they see on social media, always or sometimes.
- World events are damaging. World events are having a damaging negative effect on teens, with 82% saying they feel very or somewhat anxious or depressed by world events. Girls are taking it harder, with 85% of girls more likely to feel very or somewhat affected versus 71% of boys.



Key Takeaways

- Young people are financially savvy and boys more than girls. Nearly one third (63%) said they understand how to manage their personal finances.
- Celebrities and influencers have clout. More than half of respondents (55%) say
 that they are very or somewhat influenced by celebrities or influencers, while 46%
 say they are not.
- They'll be heading back home. Living on their own right after college isn't feasible
 for the majority of teens. Nearly half (48%) say that they expect to live at home for
 one year or more after college.
- Students know where they're going, with 73% saying they have a clear plan for what they want to do for a career.
